It is the seedbed of the whole Bible and is essential to the correct understanding of every part of it. It is the foundation on which all divine revelation rests and on which it is built up. Every great doctrine of Scripture finds its roots in Genesis in seed, type, or simple revelation. It spans over 2000 years, that is one third of our lease on the earth. Don't skip it!

Exodus: The deliverer of His people, (the promise keeper)

Parting the red sea, fire by night, cloud by day

<u>Leviticus:</u> Law maker of His House (the great detailer)

The priesthood and the protocol of approach

Numbers: The great steward (Knowledge matters)

The whole of our Christianity is founded on Num. 23:19

<u>Deuteronomy:</u> The law giver to His people (the 10 commandments) *The blessings and the curses*

Josh. The Captain of Israels Army (the promised land)

Putting Gods laws in their mouths, covenant responsibility

<u>Judges:</u> The responder to Israels Rebellion, (the only just judge)

He is not reactionary but a responder, a man of His Word.

Ruth: Our Kinsman Redeemer (the posture of humility)

The truth about submission and its rewards

I Samuel: Mans desire to be like others around them instead of like God

(God stands by His gift of a free will) King Saul

II Samuel: The man after Gods own heart (the Davidic Covenant)

Our portrait of our future life in Christ

I & II Kings: The records and failures of man's Monarchy choice over God's Theocracy.

The pride of life and its fall

I & II Chronicles: History & Genealogy of the coming Messiah

Only one God, One King and One Lord Forever to reign

Ezra: The God of Hope, (The return to re-build His House) *Priorities*

Nehemiah: The Great Governor (The return to re-build the wall) *Protection & boundaries*

Esther: The Great Protector of His people (Exposer of secrets) the power of courage

Job: The Righteous One (man is not His judge) the right friends/voices matter

<u>Psalms:</u> The Worthy One (Of all Praise, Worship, Honor and Glory)

Our present and eternal voice, what to do with our mouths!

Proverbs: Wisdom Personified (The only wise King) *Daily Bread*

Ecclesiastes: Mans failed wisdom (A portrait of backsliding and return to living for eternity)

but destiny missed!

<u>Song of Solomon:</u> Lover of our souls! *Initiation and response* <u>Isaiah:</u> Messiah Revealed (Prophet and Prophecy done right)

66 chap. In Isa. 66 books in the Bible

Jeremiah: God of Clarity, (consequences if of sin/unbelief)

Ezekiel: God the Rebuker (Pantomimes)

Last days/Armageddon, Millennium to bring repentance!

Daniel:God of the Gentiles (All the way into the Millennium)

Giver and revealer of His Holy Dreams!

Hosea: God of Repentance (Mercy, the God kind of Love, Agape)

Looks different that the worlds...

Joel: God of restoration (Pouring out His Spirit) *The new wine...*

Amos: God of information (What is sin/repentance)

In the light of how to stay blessed...

Obadiah: God of vengeance (Upon His enemies) Vengeance belongs to the Lord...

<u>Jonah</u>: The God of obedience (No Plan B) <u>Can't hide from God...</u> <u>Micah:</u> God of Purpose (To bring all mankind back to Himself)

His purpose is ours, no such thing as not knowing yours!

Nahum: Repentance rejected (What happens)

Backsliding...the end is worse than the beginning...twice dead!

<u>Habakkuk:</u> God of Holiness (His direct appeal to God and God's answer to Him)

He Knows God's judgement of sin is just and He chooses to worship Him in that place.

Zephaniah: God of Consecration **Haggai:** God the desire of all nations

Zechariah: God of Visions **Malachi:** God who changes not

He accuses man of stealing from Him and man does not repent but "back-talks" Him!

The Story of 2 Gardens: Eden / Adam fell! Gethsemane / Jesus Stood!

Matthew: Behold Your King, Jesus Mark: Behold His Servant, Jesus Luke: Behold the Man, Jesus John: Behold your God, Jesus

Acts: God the Holy Spirit (Our helper has come) The Guide into all Truth...

Romans: Gods Doctrine

<u>I Corinthians:</u> Loves walk (Your conduct)

II Corinthians: The God of ministry (meeting the need) Spelled W-O-R-K!

Galatians: The God of our Faith (your actions)

Ephesians: God of Grace (Your place and pace) *His ability & your participation of faith...*

Philippians: The God of Joy (Your choice)

Colossians: The God of Character (daily life, marriage, work)

The foundation of the Christian life lived....

<u>I Thessalonians</u>: God of your servanthood

II Thessalonians: God who comes again (Just as He said!) Hold on...

I Timothy: The God of qualifications

<u>II Timothy:</u> The God of order <u>Titus:</u> The God of discipline

Philemon: The God of recognition

Hebrews: God of the New and better covenant (The Blood supplies) *Our duties*

James: The God of Light (Your light to men)

I Peter: The God of Virtue (His power to us and in us) *His power through you...*

II Peter: The God of our security (How to remain secure in Him)

I John: God our Love (Him loving you) You loving Him

II John: God our Truth (Don't be deceived)

III John: God of our Soul Prosperity (Personal responsibility)

Jude: The God of our Salvation (Saved for!)

Revelation: God the Revelator (The great adventurer)

He Reveals to us all the final plans that will even happen even when we are not here! He wants us to know Him, to walk, talk and live and create with Him for ages to come!
