Theocracy – God’s way, highest way!

A system of government in which “priests” rule in the name of God.

Today this would be Pastors over a church, and even believers themselves walking in the Believers Authority for their personal lives.

Government by divine guidance or by officials who are regarded as divinely guided. In many theocracies, government leaders are members of the clergy, and the state's legal system is based on religious law.

The political system in which authority is exercised by God's representative on earth.

Republic – (U.S.A.) Constitution, moral epicenter, God, Bible

A state in which supreme power is held by the people and their elected representatives, and which has an elected or nominated president rather than a monarch.

Form of government in which a state is ruled by representatives of the citizen body. Modern republics are founded on the idea that sovereignty rests with the people,

While often categorized as a democracy, the United States is more accurately defined as a constitutional federal republic. What does this mean? “Constitutional” refers to the fact that government in the United States is based on a Constitution which is the supreme law of the United States.

The word republic comes from the Latin term *res publica*, which literally means "public thing", "public matter", or "public affair" and was used to refer to the state as a whole.

The 5 types of Republics are Constitutional Republic, Parliamentary Republic, Presidential Republic, Federal Republic, Theocratic Republic.

The U.S.A. is a Constitutional federal republic.

Democracy – (Other Countries, not the U.S.A.)

Not constitutionally based, majority vote based.

Ex: If murder is illegal one year by majority vote, the next year it can become legal by majority vote, no constitution to uphold or amend first!

A system of government by the whole population or all the eligible members of a state,

The word democracy comes from the Greek words "demos", meaning people, and "kratos" meaning power; so democracy can be thought of as "power of the people": a way of governing which depends on the will of the people.

“Or we could say “whim of the people” rather than the will of God/Bible as the constitution of the U.S.A. is based upon.”
