### **CHURCH ETTIQUETTE (A code of conduct)**

1. **COME**: Never miss church unless it is absolutely necessary.

George Washington's pastor said of him, "No company ever kept him from church."

**Heb 10:25** Not forsaking *or* neglecting to assemble together [as believers], as is the habit of some people, but admonishing (warning, urging, and encouraging) one another, and all the more faithfully as you see the day approaching.

2. **COME EARLY**: Rushing into church at the last minute is not conducive to true worship!

Lev 19:30 You shall keep My Sabbaths and reverence My sanctuary. I am the Lord.

## 3. COME WITH YOUR WHOLE FAMILY:

"The church service is <u>not</u> a convention that a family should merely <u>send a delegate</u>." **Josh. 24:15** "... But as for me and my family, we will serve the LORD."

#### 4. TAKE A PLACE TOWARD THE FRONT OF CHURCH:

"Leave the rear seats for those who may come late, mothers with children and backsliders."

1Ti 4:15 Practice and cultivate and meditate upon these duties; throw yourself wholly into them [as your ministry], so that your progress may be evident to everybody.

5. <u>BE DEVOUT</u>: (Deep commitment) "The church is not a theater or place of amusement. You come to worship God, not to whisper, lounge or sleep. God's house deserves our very utmost reverence." <u>Eccl. 5:1 KEEP YOUR foot [give your mind to what you are doing]</u> when you go [as Jacob to sacred Bethel] to the house of God. For to draw near to hear and obey is better than to give the sacrifice of fools [carelessly, irreverently] too ignorant to know that they are doing evil.

## 6. HELP VISITORS/GUESTS TO FIND AND FOLLOW THE SERVICE:

"If they have no Bible, share yours with them, Sing! Join in the worship! Don't just sit? **Psa 100:2** Serve the Lord with gladness! Come before His presence with singing!

# 7. ALWAYS REMEMBER THAT VISITORS ARE THE GUESTS OF THE CHURCH MEMBERS.

"Treat them with the same courtesy as you would if they should visit in your home."

1Jn 3:18 Little children, let us not love [merely] in theory or in speech but in deed and in truth (in practice and in sincerity).

8. GIVE A GOOD OFFERING TO GOD: 2Cor. 9:7 ...for God loveth a cheerful giver. Mat 10:8...freely ye have received, freely give.

9. **NEVER RUSH FOR THE DOOR**: After service is dismissed, speak and be spoken to. Be friendly and courteous.

**Gal 6:10** As we have therefore opportunity, let us do good unto all *men*, especially unto them who are of the household of faith.

#### 10. NEVER STAY AWAY FROM CHURCH BECAUSE THE CHURCH IS NOT PERFECT:

"How lonesome you would feel in a perfect church, since there would be no-one there!"

**Heb 6:1a** Therefore let us go on and get past the elementary stage in the teachings *and* doctrine of Christ (the Messiah), advancing steadily toward the completeness *and* perfection that belong to spiritual maturity.
