

## How To Train Your Child To Pray!

Be sure to clean up after yourself, teach your littles to do the same.

***Children are not to hold microphones at any time.*** If they are led to pray something during corporate prayer, you hold the mic for them.

If there are breaks during Prayer, Children can socialize with their friends, please be sure you are always supervising them, you are within ear and eye shot and can correct at a moment's notice.

If a Prayer night goes late into the night, please be mindful that children need their rest. Have them lay down with a blanket and pillow and go to sleep. If this is too difficult, one spouse should stay while one takes the child(ren) home.
