

Ten Reasons to Tithe

Tithe: to give one-tenth of all your income for the support of the church

1. Titling is a way to **HONOR** God.

“Honor the Lord with thy substance, and with the first fruits of all thine increase; So, shall thy barns be filled with plenty, and thy presses shall burst out with new wine” (Proverbs 3:9-10)

2. Titling is **REQUIRED** by God.

“Bring ye all the tithes into the storehouse, that there may be meat in mine house...” (Malachi 3:10)

3. Titling will **OPEN** the windows of **HEAVEN**.

“Bring ye all the tithes into the storehouse, that there may be meat in mine house and prove me now herewith, saith the Lord of Hosts, if I will not open you the windows of Heaven, and pour you out a blessing, that there shall not be room enough to receive it” (Malachi 3:10)

4. Titling is a **WEAPON** against Satan.

“And I will rebuke the devourer for your sakes, and he shall not destroy the fruits of your ground; neither shall your vine cast her fruit before the time in the field, saith the Lord of hosts.” (Malachi 3:11)

5. Titling shows that you **TRUST** God.

“Trust in the Lord with all thine heart and lean not to thine own understanding. In all thy ways acknowledge Him, and He shall direct thy paths” (Proverbs 3:5-6)

6. Titling shows that you **LOVE** and **OBEY** God.

“If ye love me, keep my commandments” (John 14:15)

7. Titling shows that God is **FIRST** in your life.

“But seek ye first the Kingdom of God and His righteousness and all these things shall be added unto you” (Matthew 6:33)

8. Titling is **RECOGNITION** that **EVERYTHING** belongs to God.

“The earth is the Lord’s and the fullness thereof, the world, and they that dwell therein” (Psalm 24:1)

9. Titling is a sign of a **CHEERFUL GIVER**.

“Every man according, as he has purposed in his heart, so let him give; not grudgingly, or of necessity, for God loveth a cheerful giver.” (II Cor 9:7)

10. Titling says that **GOD** is **LORD** of your life.

“And if it seems evil unto you to serve the Lord, choose you this day whom ye will serve...but as for me and my house, we will serve the Lord” (Joshua 24:15)
