2Ti 1:9 (AMP) [*For it is He*] Who delivered and saved us and called us with a calling in itself holy and leading to holiness [*to a life of consecration, a vocation of holiness*]; [*He did it*] not because of anything of merit that we have done, but because of and to further His own purpose and grace (unmerited favor) which was given us in Christ Jesus before the world began [*eternal ages ago*].

PUR'POSE, n. before, to set or place.]

That which a person sets before himself as an object to be reached or accomplished; the end or aim to which the view is directed in any plan, measure or exertion.
The reason for which something exists or is done.

PAS'SION, n. [to suffer.]

The impression or effect of an external agent upon a body; that which is suffered or received. A body at rest affords us no idea of any active power to move, and when set in motion, it is rather a passion than an action in it.
