

1. Hope for eternity, (salvation, resurrection)!

Act 24:15 And have hope toward God, which they themselves also allow, that there shall be a resurrection of the dead, both of the just and unjust.

1Co 15:19 If in this life only we have hope in Christ, we are of all men most miserable.

Col 1:5 For the hope which is laid up for you in heaven, whereof ye heard before in the word of the truth of the gospel;

1Th 5:8 But let us, who are of the day, be sober, putting on the breastplate of faith and love; and for an helmet, the hope of salvation.

Tit 1:2 In hope of eternal life, which God, that cannot lie, promised before the world began;

Tit 3:7 That being justified by his grace, we should be made heirs according to the hope of eternal life.

2. Hope for the future, (God's Glory, tomorrow and all your tomorrows)!

Rom 5:2 By whom also we have access by faith into this grace wherein we stand, and rejoice in hope of the glory of God.

Gal 5:5 For we through the Spirit wait for the hope of righteousness by faith.

1Th 1:3 Remembering without ceasing your work of faith, and labour of love, and patience of hope in our Lord Jesus Christ, in the sight of God and our Father;

Heb 3:6 But Christ as a son over his own house; whose house are we, if we hold fast the confidence and the rejoicing of the hope firm unto the end.

Heb 6:11 And we desire that every one of you do shew the same diligence to the full assurance of hope unto the end:

1Pe 1:13 Wherefore gird up the loins of your mind, be sober, and hope to the end for the grace that is to be brought unto you at the revelation of Jesus Christ;

3. Hope for today! (This hour, this moment)!

Psa 16:9 Therefore my heart is glad, and my glory rejoiceth: my flesh also shall rest in hope.

Psa 22:9 But thou *art* he that took me out of the womb: thou didst make me hope *when I was* upon my mother's breasts.

Psa 31:24 Be of good courage, and he shall strengthen your heart, all ye that hope in the LORD.

Psa 33:18 Behold, the eye of the LORD is upon them that fear him, upon them that hope in his mercy;

Psa 33:22 Let thy mercy, O LORD, be upon us, according as we hope in thee.

Psa 38:15 For in thee, O LORD, do I hope: thou wilt hear, O Lord my God.

Psa 42:5 Why art thou cast down, O my soul? and *why* art thou disquieted in me? hope thou in God: for I shall yet praise him *for* the help of his countenance.

Psa 42:11 Why art thou cast down, O my soul? and why art thou disquieted within me? hope thou in God: for I shall yet praise him, *who is* the health of my countenance, and my God.

Psa 71:14 But I will hope continually, and will yet praise thee more and more.

Psa 78:7 That they might set their hope in God, and not forget the works of God, but keep his commandments:

Psa 119:49 ZAIN. Remember the word unto thy servant, upon which thou hast caused me to hope.

Psa 119:114 Thou *art* my hiding place and my shield: I hope in thy word.

Hope is found in the Word when you are hidden in it!

Psa 131:3 Let Israel hope in the LORD from henceforth and for ever.

Pro 10:28 The hope of the righteous *shall be* gladness: but the expectation of the wicked shall perish.

Pro 13:12 Hope deferred maketh the heart sick: but *when* the desire cometh, *it is* a tree of life.

In Jer. God is called the hope of Israel and their fathers, a person, the hope of His prophets and His people. He is with us always, Hope is with us always!

Zec 9:12 Turn you to the strong hold, ye prisoners(yoked in battle harnessed, held, kept, made ready, prepared) of hope: even today do I declare *that* I will render double unto thee;

Rom 4:18 Who against hope believed in hope, that he might become the father of many nations, according to that which was spoken, So shall thy seed be.

Gen. 15:1-5

Rom 12:12 Rejoicing in hope; patient in tribulation; continuing instant in prayer;

Rom 15:13 Now the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace in believing, that ye may abound in hope, through the power of the Holy Ghost.

1Co 9:10 Or saith he *it* altogether for our sakes? For our sakes, no doubt, *this* is written: that he that ploweth should plow in hope; and that he that thresheth in hope should be partaker of his hope.

1Co 13:13 And now abideth faith, hope, charity, these three; but the greatest of these *is* charity.

1Co 15:19 If in this life only we have hope in Christ, we are of all men most miserable.

Eph 1:18 The eyes of your understanding being enlightened; that ye may know what is the hope of his calling, and what the riches of the glory of his inheritance in the saints,

Col 1:23 If ye continue in the faith grounded and settled, and *be* not moved away from the hope of the gospel, which ye have heard,

2Th 2:16 Now our Lord Jesus Christ himself, and God, even our Father, which hath loved us, and hath given *us* everlasting consolation and good hope through grace,

Heb 6:18 That by two immutable things, in which *it was* impossible for God to lie, we might have a strong consolation, who have fled for refuge to lay hold upon the hope set before us:

Heb 6:19 Which *hope* we have as an anchor of the soul, both sure and steadfast, and which entereth into that within the veil;

1Pe 3:15 But sanctify the Lord God in your hearts: and *be* ready always to *give* an answer to every man that asketh you a reason of the hope that is in you with meekness and fear:

1Jn 3:3 And every man that hath this hope in him purifieth himself, even as he is pure.
